ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL

ARRIVAL TIME: Between 7:45 and 8:25 A.M. (This time may be extended in the first few weeks of school.)

<u>Arrivals:</u> In the mornings both Crowder Blvd. and Hayne Blvd. are used for drop-offs. Hayne Blvd. entrance will open at 7:45 A.M., and the Crowder Blvd. gate will open at 7:45 A.M. and close at 8:25 A.M. Parents living to the east of the school must approach from Hayne Blvd. – not Crowder Blvd. If you live west of the school, please use the Crowder Blvd. drop-off area. **Do not make a u-turn from Crowder into the front entrance gate between 7:45 A.M.** – **9:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M.** – **3:15 P.M.** This cuts off people waiting to turn into the yard from the east and is discourteous. We will temporarily extend times due to the touch-free temperature checks and hand sanitation required before entering the classroom. Students in 3rd grade and up must wear face coverings, and students in pre-kindergarten — 2nd grade are encouraged to wear face coverings (based on current guidelines in place). The tardy bell will ring at 8:25 (again, this time maybe extended for the first few weeks). Any student arriving after the tardy bell must be signed in, and a parent must sign the tardy slip. Parents, please do not exit your vehicle.

DISMISSAL TIMES: The dismissal time of the oldest child you are picking up or carpooling with will be used.

It is imperative that parents do not pull into the schoolyard and block entrance for the drive.

Dismissals: Students will be dismissed from classrooms with no groups convening in the dismissal area. Children remaining for after-school care will be dismissed at 3:10 to the pavilion area. Do not arrive prior to your child's scheduled dismissal time. Please use the following protocols to enhance the dismissal process.

- Drive through the designated car line.
- Place placard in front windshield with names (including last names) and grades of each child riding in your carpool.
- Please be courteous, patient, and exercise extreme caution.
- Should any emergency arise (hurricanes, severe weather, etc.) please tune in to local television/radio stations or to the Lake Castle website for any announcements.

If your child is in Grade 3 or below, your child must wear a nametag through September 30. No one will be accepted without this information on his/her clothing. In order for your child to be directed to the proper room in the morning and ushered to the correct P.M. area in the afternoon, it is of paramount importance that you adhere to the aforementioned.

<u>DO NOT</u> walk your child(ren) into or out the gates of the school. Absolutely under <u>no</u> circumstances should you get out of the car with the engine still running.
